Each year, in accordance with OSA's bylaws, a summary of the audited financial statements is made available to you. The audited financial statements were accepted by the Audit Council and the Board of Directors at the March 2020 meetings. BDO USA, LLP, OSA's outside independent accountants, performed the audit of the 2019 consolidating OSA and OSA Foundation financial statements.

The consolidated OSA and OSA Foundation's



net worth is US\$124 million as of 31 December 2019. The success of OSA and OSA Foundation's programs, together with strong financial and investment management, have allowed OSA and the OSA Foundation to accumulate an investment portfolio totaling US\$129 million. As in past years, OSA continues to absorb the Foundation's administrative costs and matched new contributions

dollar for dollar in 2019. OSA's support enables the OSA Foundation to have more

funds available to directly support its valuable programs.

Essential to OSA's mission and successful operation are the contributions of its members and volunteers as authors, editors, reviewers, program committee members, speakers, and governance leaders. These individuals have been fully engaged with staff during the COVID-19 pandemic to deliver publications, virtual meetings and schools, webinars and other online content, while reaching out to the community to offer support.


